

Petition to the House of Commons in Parliament Assembled

We the undersigned residents of Canada draw attention to the House to do the following:

THAT, over 4,500 Canadians are awaiting a life-saving organ or tissue transplant;

AND THAT, the overwhelming majority of Canadians do support organ and tissue donation, but only 25% are currently registered as donors;

AND THAT, we need to make it easier for Canadians to register as organ and tissue donors to save more lives.

THEREFORE, your petitioners call upon Parliament to support Bill C-316 so that Canadians are able indicate their desire to donate their organs and tissues through their annual tax return, and that this information be shared with their provincial or territorial government for the purposes of being added to existing donor registries.
